MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR No. 2 Series of 1999

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT OF MC No. 08, SERIES OF 1996: FORMS FOR

MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF ARB INFORMATION AND

EDUCATION PROGRAMS'

I. PREFATORY STATEMENT:

The Memorandum Circular No. 10, Series of 1999 which took effect on 17 May 1999 was issued as a support mechanism in the implementation of the expanded framework for ARC development.

The MC aims to provide directions and synchronize all the information and education interventions that will lead to the desired outcome in the three (3) modalities of expanded agrarian reform communities which is functional organizations/institutions able to manage their own area-based rural enterprises to increase farm productivity and income.

In order to generate accurate information on how the information and education programs have been carried out and based on the needs of the ARBs in each ARC model, the monitoring and evaluation system for the information and education/training programs for ARBs stated in MC 08, Series of 1996 was revised. However, the structure, accountabilities and schedule/reporting systems from the field level to the central office level stated therein shall still be enforced.

H. BACKGROUND:

The Education/Training Program for ARB Forms 1-3 (ETPARB 1-3) is the monitoring report prescribed under MC 08, Series of 1996. The data generated under this monitoring report format had been limited to the title of training, number of participants attended, number of batches conducted and sources of fund. The training ouput, follow-through activities and the contribution of the education/training programs to the other components of the ARC are not clearly defined in the said instrument. Likewise, the said MC does not include data on the IEC materials developed, accessed and distributed for program implementation.

The Manual on the Operationalization of the Information and Education Program for ARBs which was developed for the operationalization of MC 10, Series of 1999, requires the municipal, provincial, regional and central officers to institute the monitoring and evaluation for the ARB I and E program implementation in three (3) levels.

The first level shall be undertaken during the actual conduct of the I and E training/activity which ensures that the I and E intervention is delivered based on the agreed design and result of the training needs assessment (TNA). The ARB Training Officers may adopt the suggested training evaluation formats presented in the said manual or may develop their own evaluation instrument. This shall determine the learning level of the participants after the training and guide the improvement of the trainings conducted.

The second level of M and E system focuses on the application of the learnings and implementation of the follow-through activities. The basis of monitoring shall be the reentry plan/s prepared during the education/training activity. It ensures that follow-through activities are carried out and learnings/skills acquired are fully adopted.

The third level of M and E shall determines how the ARB I and E program is integrated to the overall direction of the ARC development program. Three (3) types of instruments shall be prepared and consolidated in order to come-up with the provincewide, regionwide and nationwide status report of the ARB I and E program implementation in the three models of the ARCs.

To come up with a common understanding on the data to be generated, the description or instructions on how to fill-up the M and E forms for ARB I and E program implementation is hereunder presented.

III. INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO FILL-UP THE FORMS FOR M&E SYSTEM OF ARB I & E PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION

The following forms shall be used in the monitoring of the ARB I and E program implementation.

- 1. Education/Training Program for Agrarian Reform Beneficiaries (ETPARB Forms 1-3) (Annex A)
- 1.1 The ETPARB shall be the quarterly report for the education and training programs conducted in the ARCs. Aside from the information required under MC 8 Series of 1996, training output/s, follow-through activities and source and amount of funds are included in the instrument. These information shall facilitate the monitoring of the application of learnings as well as the utilization of ARBD and ARIE funds. Three (3) types of ETPARB forms shall be used:
 - ETPARB Form 1: shall be prepared by the Development Facilitators (DFs) and certified by the concerned MAROs. This accomplishment report shall be submitted to the provincial office every 5th day of the succeeding month of every quarter, e.g. the First Quarter Report (January March 2000) shall be submitted on 05 April 2000.
 - ETPARB Form 2: shall be the consolidation of the education and training programs conducted in the ARCs reported in the ETPARB Form 1. It shall be prepared by the Provincial ARB Training Officer/s and certified by the CARPO for BDCD. This provincial consolidated accomplishment report shall be submitted to the regional office every 10th day of the succeeding month of every quarter with ETPARB Form 1 as supporting document, e.g. the First Quarter Report (January March 2000) shall be submitted on 10 April 2000.
 - ETPARB Form 3: shall be the regional consolidation of the education and training programs conducted in the ARCs. It shall be prepared by the Regional ARB Training Officers/s and certified by the CARPO for SSD. This regional consolidated accomplishment report shall be submitted to BARBD every 15th day of the succeding month of every quarter together with ETPARB Form 2 as supporting documents, e.g. the First Quarter Report (January March 2000) shall be submitted on 15 April 2000.

- 1.2 BARBD shall prepare the national consolidation and management report of the education and training programs on a quarterly basis.

2. Monitoring and Evaluation for Training Modules and IEC Materials Development/Production and Distribution (Annex B)

- 2.1 This monitoring tool intends to track down the activities undertaken for massive information campaign to increase awareness and generate support for program implementation using training modules and IEC materials developed and distributed at all levels.
- 2.1 This semestral report shall be prepared at the provincial, regional and national levels using the same form.

The ARB Training Officers shall prepare the report in coordination with and countersigned by the designated Provincial Information Officer (PIO). The report shall be certified by the BDCD CARPOs and submitted to regional office every 10th day of the succeeding month of every semester, e.g. the First Semestral Report (January - June 2000) shall be submitted on 10 July 2000.

At the regional office, two (2) types of report shall be prepared: 1) consolidation of reports submitted by the provincial offices; and 2) activities solely undertaken by the region in coordination with its Regional Information Officers. The report shall be conutersigned by the Regional Information Officer (RIO) and certified by the CARPO for SSD for submission to BARBD every 15th day of the succeeding month of every semester, e.g. the First Semestral Report (January - June 2000) shall be submitted on 15 July 2000.

- 2.3 BARBD shall prepare the national consolidation of the training modules and IEC materials development/production and distribution on a semestral basis.
- 2.4 Below is the description on how to fill-up the said instrument.

3. ARC I and E Program Monitoring for Outcome and Output Indicators (Annex C)

- 3.1 This M and E instrument intends to measure the contribution of the I and E programs, to the overall implementation of the ARC development based on the activities reported in ETPARB and training modules and IEC material development and distribution monitoring report.
- 3.2 This semestral monitoring instrument shall be prepared at the provincial, regional and national levels using the same form including an analysis on how the I and E activities addressed the needs of the specific ARCs or in correlation to the level of development of these ARCs:

The Provincial ARB Training Officer shall prepare the report. The report shall be certified by the CARPO for BDCD and submitted to the regional office every 10th day of the month of the succeeding month of every semester. (Example: The submission of the Semestral Report for January to June 2000 is on 10 July 2000.)

At the regional office, the Regional ARB Training Officer/s shall prepare the report. It shall be certified by the CARPO for SSD and submitted to BARBD every 15th day of the month of the succeeding month of every semster. (Example: The submission of the Semestral Report for January to June 2000 is on 15 July 2000.)
