## **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT:**

The fabrics should have undergone the necessary tests on the composition of the fabrics and other properties, conducted by the Philippine Textile Research Institute (PTRI) of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) and should therefore, have corresponding Test Results. (Ref. Rule IV Certification Requirement and Rule V Procurement Procedure)

If the Test Results are still not available at the time of bid submission, the bidder should submit a Certification stating that the fabrics they will be using have undergone the necessary tests pending the issuance of the Test Results.

The Test Results should be available during post-qualification.

NOTE: Bidders are encouraged to contact the following accredited textile suppliers of Philippine Tropical Fabrics (PTF) by the PTRI-DOST as possible sources of the prescribed fabrics:
