MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

SUBJECT: ORGANIZATION OF A JOINT DAR-LBP FIELD TASK FORCE ON
UNPAID DISTRIBUTED LANDS UNDER CARP

In order to fast-track Landowners' compensation of landholdings that have been distributed under the Agrarian Reform Program but whose landowners have not yet been paid, all DAR Regional Directors and Provincial Agrarian Reform Program Officers are directed to immediately undertake the following:

1. In close collaboration with their respective Land Bank of the Philippines' counterparts, organize a **Joint DAR-LBP Task Force** who shall be tasked primarily to identify and pinpoint aforesaid landholdings; and, thereafter, generate and/or complete the corresponding claimfolders for immediate processing and payment by the LBP;
2. To see to it that all problems and issues identified by the Task Force are immediately resolved, as well as the needed technical and budgetary support are adequately and timely provided; and
3. To give top priority on all activities and/or actions required to ensure payment of subject landholdings at the earliest time possible;

A bi-monthly status report shall be submitted by the PAROs to the Regional Directors who shall integrate the same to the Regional Reports which shall be submitted to the Office of the Undersecretary for Field Operations and Support Services through the Assistant Secretary for Field Operations and Support Services.

SUBJECT : Response to the Secretary's Memorandum dated 21 July 1993 Re: Joint DAR-LBP Task Force

Anent your Memorandum dated 21 July 1993, please be informed of the following:

1. It may be recalled that a Task Force on OLT Completion has been organized in the Central Office precisely to expedite and ensure the completion of Operation Land Transfer (OLT) pursuant to PD 27 and EO 228. This Task Force is chaired by no less than Undersecretary Jose Noel D. Olano and with the undersigned, BLAD Director Gloria Fabia, representatives from BALA, DAR Field Office, and LBP key officials as members. One of the critical concerns being addressed by the Task Force is the completion of Claim Folders (CFs) to effect landowners compensation at the earliest possible time. An Executive Situationer on OLT implementation dated 15 July 1993 was earlier submitted to your Office highlighting the specific activities and/or actions being undertaken to accelerate OLT implementation. (A copy is enclosed for your ready reference)
2. In compliance to your instruction per Memorandum dated 21 July 1993, we have prepared the attached Memorandum Circular for your approval, directing DAR Regional Directors and Provincial Agrarian Reform Officers to organize a **Joint DAR-LBP Task Force** in their respective areas of jurisdiction in close collaboration with their counterparts in the Land Bank of the Philippines.

The Task Force shall be tasked to identify and pinpoint subject landholdings, generate and complete the corresponding landowners' claim folders (CFs) for immediate processing and payment by the LBP. Moreover, the RDs and the PAROs shall see to it that these undertakings be given top priority.

3. Our Office is continuously coordinating with the Offices of LBP Executive Vice-President Jesus Diaz, Vice-President Ruben Mabagos of the LBP-Landowners Compensation Department I, Vice-President for Landowners Compensation and Assistance Group Mr. Roberto Ong, and the LBP's Special Unit on Land Transfer Action (SULTRA), in order to address issues and problems related to land acquisition and distribution and landowners compensation particularly on OLT areas.
