CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this ____ day of November 2019 between the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR) of Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City, Philippines, (hereinafter called "the Procuring Entity"), of the one part and SANTOYO CLOTHLINE CREATION, of No. 15A M. 4. The Procuring Entity hereby covenants to pay the Supplier in consideration of the provision of the prescribed uniforms and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the contract at the time and in the manner prescribed by the contract. In case of delays in the delivery/performance of the required services specified in this Contract due to the Service Provider's fault, the Procuring Entity shall deduct from the Contract Price, as liquidated damages, the applicable rate of one tenth (1/10) of one percent of the cost of the unperformed portion for every day of delay until actual delivery or performance. The maximum deduction shall be ten percent (10%) of the amount of contract. Once the maximum is reached, the Procuring Entity may rescind or terminate the Contract pursuant to GCC Clause 23, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.
