RESOLUTION NO. 42, SERIES OF 2019

**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR
THE PROCUREMENT OF LOT 4- TWO (2) UNITS RICE COMBINE
HARVESTER TO ALL CERTIFIED EQUIPMENT TRADING
CORPORATION**

WHEREAS, the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR) is mandated to respond to the development requirements of the Agrarian Reform Beneficiary Organizations (ARBOs) through the provision of appropriate farm machineries and equipment that will enable them to become climate resilient;

WHEREAS, in response to these development requirements, the DAR through the Office of the Undersecretary for Support Services intends to apply from the continuing General Appropriations Act (GAA) of 2018 the sum of Philippine Pesos One Hundred Million One Hundred Twenty Nine Thousand Three Hundred Pesos only (PhP100,129,300.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for payments under the contract for the supply and delivery of farm machineries and equipment comprising of five (5) lots for the "Climate Resilient Farm Productivity Support Project;

WHEREAS, on September 7, 2019, the Department of Agrarian Reform-Bids and Awards Committee-Primary (DAR-BAC Primary) posted the Invitation to Bid (ITB) in the DAR website, DAR bulletin board, and the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) website with reference no. 6450669,(refer to Annex "A" copy of PhilGEPs posting);

WHEREAS, six (6) bidders acquired bidding documents, namely: 1) ADA Manufacturing Corp.; 2) Agricomponent Corp.; 3) All Certified Equipment Trading Corporation; 4) Ford Tractor Phils. Inc.; 5) P.I. Farm Products, Inc.; and 6) Fortune Tract Agro Sales, Inc.

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2019, the DAR-BAC conducted a pre-bidding conference which was attended by sixteen (16) interested bidders;

WHEREAS, as a result of the pre-bidding conference, Supplemental Bid Bulletin (SBB) No. 1 was issued on September 24, 2019 to incorporate in the Philippine Bidding Documents some changes

in the Instructions to Bidders (ITB) and General Conditions of Contract (GCC) pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 07-2019 and 12-2019, clarifications on the Bid Data Sheet (BDS), and some revisions on the Technical Specifications of Lots 1 to3, 4 & 5 (refer to Annex "B", copy of SBB no. 1);

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2019, the deadline of submission of bids, four (4) of the five (5) bidders that purchased bidding documents submitted their bid proposals for lot 4 and the result of eligibility and preliminary check of their bid submission is shown below, (refer to Annex "C" Abstract of Bids):

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2019, the BAC-TWG conducted the detailed technical evaluation of the LCB and found out that there were some required specifications that cannot be validated from the AMTEC test report and the brochure submitted (refer to Annex "D" Detailed Bid Evaluation Report);

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2018, the BAC-TWG requested permission from the BAC-Primary to seek AMTEC's advise on the above concern, and on October 23, 2019 the BAC-TWG learned from AMTEC that the required specifications that cannot be validated from the brochure and the AMTEC test report can be seen through ocular inspection of the brand and model of the offered rice combine harvester;


WHEREAS, on October 28, 2019, during the BAC-Primary meeting, the BAC-Primary instructed the Technical Working Group (TWG) to conduct the post-qualification evaluation of the LCB, All Certified Equipment Trading Corporation;


WHEREAS, on November 5, 2019, the BAC-TWG conducted the post-qualification evaluation of All Certified Equipment Trading Corporation and reported to the BAC-Primary in its meeting on November 6, 2019 that the LCB is responsive to all the requirements of


the bidding documents issued by DAR (refer to Annex "E" Post-qualification Evaluation Report).


WHEREFORE, premises considered, the BAC-Primary resolved to recommend to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE) the award of contract for Lot 4 described above to All Certified Equipment Trading Corporation being the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder (LCRB) in the total amount of **Philippine Pesos Two Million Nine Hundred Forty Thousand only (PhP 2,940,000.00.00)** inclusive of all applicable taxes.


