**BAC Resolution No. 08 Series of 2017**

**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACTS FOR THE  
PROCUREMENT OF VEHICLES (LOTS 1 & 2) FOR THE CONVERGE PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR), through the loan proceeds from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) with counterpart funds from the General Appropriations Act (GAA) of 2016 for the Convergence on Value Chain Enhancement For Rural Growth and Empowerment (CONVERGE) Project, intends to apply the sum of Seventeen Million Nine Hundred Seventy-One Thousand Pesos only (Php 17,971,000.00), being the total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC), to payments under the contracts for the procurement of four (4) units 4 x 4 ( Lot 1) and twelve (12) units of 4 x 2 (Lot 2) pick-up type vehicles for mobility support to the project;

**WHEREAS**, on December 6, 2016 and March 15, 2017, the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) approved BAC Resolutions no. 15, series of 2016, and no. 5, series of 2017, declaring failure of bidding and the conduct of rebidding, respectively, for the procurement of four (4) units 4 x 4 (Lot 1) and twelve (12) units 4 x 2 (Lot 2) pick-up vehicles for the CONVERGE Project (refer to Annex "A" for copy of said BAC Resolutions);

**WHEREAS**, on April 1, 2017, the Department of Agrarian Reform-Bids and Awards Committee (DAR-BAC) posted the Invitation to Bid (rebid) (ITB) in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) with reference no. 4441166 and DAR website/bulletin board, and published the said ITB at the Philippine Daily Inquirer on the same date (refer to Annex "B" for copy of ITB and PhilGEPS posting);

**WHEREAS**, three (3) bidders, namely: (1) Diamond Motors Corporation; (2) Nissan Broadway Motor Sales Corporation, UN Avenue; and (3) Toyota Quezon Avenue, Inc. acquired bidding documents;

**WHEREAS**, on April 10, 2017, the DAR-BAC conducted a pre-bidding conference which was attended by two (2) interested bidders, namely: (1) Diamond Motors Corporation; and (2) Nissan Broadway Motor Sales Corporation, UN Avenue;

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the pre-bidding conference, Supplemental Bid Bulletin (SBB) No. 1 was issued on April 17, 2017 to amend certain provisions under Sections V, VI, and VII (Special Conditions, Schedule of Requirements and Technical Specifications) of the bidding documents (refer to Annex "C", copy of SBB no. 1)

**WHEREAS**, on April 24, 2017, the deadline of submission of bids, the BAC opened the bids of three bidders that submitted their bid proposals, namely: (1) Diamond Motors Corporation; and (2) Nissan Broadway Motor Sales Corporation, UN Avenue for Lot 1 ; and (3) Toyota Quezon Avenue, Inc. for Lot 2. However, only two (2) qualified for the opening of the second envelope because Nissan Broadway Motor Sales Corporation, UN Avenue failed in the submission of the correct format of the Omnibus Sworn Statement (refer to Annex "D" for copy of Abstract of Bids as read);

**WHEREAS**, the BAC Chair instructed the BAC-TWG to proceed with the detailed evaluation of the bids received and send an official notice for the disqualification of Nissan Broadway Motor Sales Corporation immediately. The presentation of the bid evaluation results by the BAC-TWG was then scheduled on May 3, 2017.

**WHEREAS**, on May 3, 2017, the BAC-TWG reported that the disqualified bidder did not file a Motion for Reconsideration while the two (2) qualified bidders passed the detailed evaluation with the findings summarized below (refer to Annex "E" for the copy of detailed evaluation report):

**WHEREAS**, the BAC confirmed the findings of the BAC-TWG and asked them to proceed with the post-qualification evaluation along with the end-user representative and observers;

**WHEREAS**, on May 10 and 11, 2017, the BAC-TWG with the end-user representative conducted post-qualification evaluation of Diamond Motors Corporation and Toyota Quezon Avenue, Inc. to check the authenticity of documents and statements submitted;

**WHEREAS**, on May 15, 2017, during the BAC regular meeting, the BAC-TWG presented to the BAC that, as a result of the post-qualification conducted, both bidders were found responsive to the requirements of the bidding documents (refer to Annex "F" for the Post-qualification Evaluation Report). The BAC then confirmed the BAC-TWG's post-qualification evaluation report and declared that Diamond Motors Corporation, is the Single Calculated Responsive Bidder for Lot 1, while Toyota Quezon Avenue, Inc., is the Single Calculated Responsive Bidder for Lot 2;

**WHEREFORE**, premises considered, the BAC resolved to recommend to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) the award of contracts for the following bidders declared to be the Single Calculated Responsive Bidders upon the issuance of No Objection to the award by the IFAD:


