



MINISTRY MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. ¹⁸⁵ / ~~17-16-85~~

For the orderly and peaceful relocation of families affected by the Manila Water Supply Project III of the Metropolitan Waterworks Sewerage System (MWSS) in Tanay, Rizal, the Inter-Agency Committee created by President Ferdinand E. Marcos formed a Task Force for Famy-Real Relocatees to be composed of two (2) representatives each from the Metropolitan Waterworks Sewerage System (MWSS), the Ministry of Natural Resources - Bureau of Forest Development (MNR-BFD) and the Ministry of Agrarian Reform (MAR) to undertake the following activities:


- a. Study and assess the specific areas within the delineated portions of Famy-Real (which are to be chosen by the relocatees) and to recommend to the Steering Committee the most appropriate relocation site considering established rights, if any;
- b. Update the BFD census of existing occupants and determine if they are bona-fide residents or pioneers in the area;
- c. Work for the amendment of Presidential Proclamation No. 1631;
- d. Coordinate closely with the leaders of the relocatees in program planning, implementation and development of the relocation site including the preparation of the subdivision scheme and the system and procedures on awarding of lots;
- e. Prepare and submit procedures to assist the relocatees secure lands thru stewardship contracts; and
- f. Render monthly reports to the Steering Committee thru the MWSP-III Relocation Office on the progress, problems or recommendations related to the assigned program of activities.

For the above purposes, the following are designated as representatives of the MAR in said Task Force:
