SUBJECT: Seminar-Workshop on Agrarian Reform for Educators

1. For information and appropriate action, the Ministry of Agrarian Reform, in collaboration with the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports through some educational institutions, will conduct for the fifth consecutive year, the SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON AGRARIAN REFORM FOR EDUCATORS this summer 1985. This is designed to enhance the effectiveness of teachers/educators who will be involved in the teaching of agrarian reform concepts. This activity supports the Ministry's project of integrating agrarian reform concepts into the educational system.
2. This summer course will be offered in five selected colleges and university in some regions of the country. Participants taking the course will earn 2 or 3 units as an elective subject in the graduate studies.
3. The program of study includes a sequence of topics to be handled by resource speakers from the Ministry in both Central and Regional Offices, Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, Ministry of Agriculture, Agrarian Reform Institute, Land Bank of the Philippines, National Congress of Farmers' Organizations; audio-visual presentations; preparation of Seminar/Term Paper; workshop sessions and a field trip to an agrarian reform area.
4. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports under a separate Memorandum shall authorize the conduct of this activity. Accordingly, the Regional Directors of involved regions are hereby requested to coordinate with their local counterparts from the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports in the successful conduct of the activity and provide support as maybe necessary.
5. The Agrarian Reform Education Service (ARES) will assist each institution involved with Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) from FARE in connection with the activity. The MAR Regional Offices

will provide such assistance as coordinating resource speakers from local agencies; coordinating field visit to an agrarian reform area; provide transportation support and counterpart personnel within their respective area to work with ARES Coordinators.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement is made and entered into in Quezon City, Philippines, by and between:

The Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System, herein referred to as MWSS, with office at Katipunan Road, Balara, Quezon City, represented by its Deputy Minister, MPWH and Ex-Officio General Manager, Aber P. Canlas.

- and -

The Ministry of Natural Resources, herein referred to as the MNR, with office at Visayas Ave., Quezon City, represented by its Deputy Minister, Arnold B. Caoili.

- and -

The Ministry of Agrarian Reform, herein referred to as MAR, with office at Elliptical Road, Quezon City, represented by its Deputy Minister, Benjamin R. Labayan.

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Committee was created by His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos as per Memorandum Order No. 725 dated May 19, 1981, for the orderly and peaceful relocation of families affected by the Manila Water Supply Project III of the Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System;

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Committee in its meeting on June 1, 1984 has decided that San Ysiro, Antipolo, Rizal is the primary relocation site while Famy-Real, Laguna and Quezon, serves as a supplemental relocation site;

WHEREAS, it was resolved during the meeting of the Inter-Agency Committee on June 1, 1984, that full development program shall be extended to the relocatees in San Ysiro while the limited services in Famy-Real shall only include the provision of access road, construction of school buildings, assistance in the subdivision of lots and in securing lands thru stewardship contract from the Ministry of Natural Resources - Bureau of Forest Development;

WHEREAS, the proposed relocation site in Famy-Real is covered by Presidential Proclamation No. 1636 which declares the area as National Parks, Wildlife Sanctuary and Game Preserve;

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Committee as provided by Memorandum Order No. 725 is authorized to call upon any department, office, agency or any government entity for such assistance as it may need in the discharge of its functions and the attainment of its objectives;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the preceding premises the parties hereby agree to the following:

- (1) That a Task Force shall be created for Famy-Real Relocatees initially composed of two (2) representatives each from the Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System, the Ministry of Natural Resources-Bureau of Forest Development and the

Ministry of Agrarian Reform to undertake the following activities indicated herein:

- a. Study and assess the specific area within the delineated portion of Famy-Real which are to be chosen by the relocatees, to be able to jointly recommend to the Steering Committee the most appropriate relocation site with due consideration to established private rights, if any;
 - b. Secure and update the BFD census on the existing occupants to determine if they are bona fide residents or pioneers in the area;
 - c. Work for the amendment of Presidential Proclamation No. 1636;
 - d. Coordinate closely with the leaders of the relocatees re: the planning and implementation of the relocation site including the subdivision of lots and the system of awarding;
 - e. Prepare and submit procedures in assisting the relocatees to secure lands thru stewardship contracts;
 - f. Render a monthly report to the Steering Committee thru the MWSP III-Relocation Office on the progress, problems or recommendations related to the assigned program of activities.
2. That MNR-BFD shall field four (4) Forest Guards to ensure that the entry of new occupants in the proposed relocation site is prevented or denied;
 3. That the projected cost estimates needed by the Task Force including the administrative support, shall be submitted for review and/or approval by MWSS;
 4. That based on the accomplished activities of the Task Force, the Steering Committee may determine the termination of the Memo of Agreement.

This Agreement shall take effect immediately upon approval.




