MINISTRY MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 3 84 Series of 1984

SUBJECT: Summer Course on Agrarian Reform for Educators

- 1. For information and appropriate action, the Ministry of Agrarian Reform, in collaboration with the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports through some educational institutions, will conduct for the fourth consecutive year, the SUMMER COURSE ON AGRARIAN REFORM FOR EDUCATORS this summer 1984. This is designed to enhance the effectiveness of teachers/educators who will be involved in the teaching of agrarian reform concepts. This activity supports the Ministry's project of interpreting agrarian reform concepts into the educational system.
- 2. This summer course will be offered in selected schools, colleges and universities in some regions of the country. Participants taking the course will earn 2 Or 3 units as an elective subject in the graduate studies.
- The program of study includes a sequence of topics to be handled by resource speakers from the Ministry in both Central and Regional Offices, Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, Ministry of Agriculture, Agrarian Reform Institute, Land Bank of the Philippines, National Congress of Farmers' Organizations; audio-visual presentations; workshop sessions and a field trip to an agrarian reform area.
- 4. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports under a separate Memorandum, has authorized the conduct of this activity. Accordingly, the Regional Directors of involved regions are hereby requested to coordinate with their local counterparts from the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports in the successful conduct of the activity and provide support as maybe necessary.
- 5. The Agrarian Reform Education Service (ARES) will assist each institution involved with four thousand pesos (P4,000.00) from FARE and necessary agrarian reform curriculum materials in connection with the activity. The MAR Regional Offices will provide such assistance as coordinating resource speakers from local agencies; coordinating field visit to agrarian area;



provide transportation support and counterpart personnel within their respective area to work with ARES Coordinators.

6. Compliance with this Memorandum Circular is earnestly enjoined.
