MINISTRY MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 3-81

TO

: Bureau Directors, Chiefs of Services and Regional Directors

SUBJECT : Summer Course on Agrarian Reform for Educators

- 1. For information and appropriate action, the Ministry of Agrarian Reform in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and Culture, through some educational institutions, will conduct the summer course on agrarian reform for educators this summer 1931. This is designed for teachers who will be involved in the teaching of agrarian reform, so that they may become instruments to hasten the development process.
- 2. The series of seminar-workshops will be held in selected state or private teachers colleges and universities in most regions of the country this summer to be credited 2 or 3 units as an elective subject in the masteral program.
- 3. The program of study includes a sequence of topics to be handled by resource speakers from the Ministry, including its Regional offices, Ministry of Education and Culture, Ministry of Agriculture, Agrarian Reform Institute and Land Bank of the Philippines; the use of relevant audio-visual instructional materials, the analysis of case studies on agrarian reform, field trips to land reform areas and other curriculum enrichment activities.
- 4. A line-up of resource speakers who will handle the Sessions is tentatively listed in the course syllabus.
- 5. The Ministry of Education and Culture, under a separate Memorandum has authorized the conduct of this activity. Accordingly, the regional directors of involved regions are hereby requested to coordinate with their local counterparts from the Ministry of Education and Culture in the successful conduct of the regional activity and provide support as may be necessary.
- 6. The Agrarian Reform Education Service (ARES) will assist each college or university involved with four thousand pesos (#4,000.00) from FARE and necessary agrarian reform instructional materials in connection with the activity. The MAR Regional Offices will provide such

assistance as coordinating resource speakers from local agencies involved; coordinating field visits to a land reform area; provide transportation support and counterpart personnel to work with ARES coordinators.

7. Compliance with this Memorandum is earnestly enjoined.
