DEPARTMENT MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 14

T O: Bureau Directors, Chiefs of Services, and Regional Directors

SUBJECT: Guidelines on the Programs and Projects
Approved for Fund Assistance From the
Fund For Agrarian Reform Education For
the Calendar Year 1978

- 1. The Programs and Projects for fund assistance from the Fund for Agrarian Reform Education (FARE) which has been approved by the Department and for funding by the Secretary of Finance as Chairman of the Agrarian Reform Investment Committee in his letter 14 April 1977 and is now incorporated into the General Appropriations Decree, PD No. 1250, for implementation by the Department through the Agrarian Reform Education Service. (See attached Summary.)
- 2. In consonance with and in support to the Department's Agenda for 1978, the following guidelines are provided in order to attain a balanced provision for both clientele and personnel development activities.
 - a. For PROGRAMS A & B Departmental units (Central or Regional), for which direct assistance will be provided, should submit a Training Plan or Design to ARES requesting the use of the Fund, and indicating what counterpart arrangements will be made for the activity.

Direct assistance could take care of the following:

1. If earmarked for clientele development activities: 1 meal and 2 snacks per day of participants especially if they are the agrarian reform beneficiaries: farmers and their farm family, landowners, community elements.

- 2. If earmarked under Personnel Development: training materials and other logistic requirements, honorarium for resource persons at rates comparable in the region. The regions are supposed to program for transportation, per diems, other administrative costs for training from their own regional allocations.
- 3. Under PROGRAM D, the Fund provides a Pl0,000 assistance to Regions II and V which have set up their Regional Training Centers. Other regions should try to do the same so they can also be programmed for assistance in the next calendar year. The amount may be used to purchase furniture, training equipment or training facilities depending on their requirements provided that prior consultation with ARES shall be made for programming of funds.
- 4. A Statement of Expenditures duly certified by the Regional Accountant and certified by the Auditor in case of direct assistance should be submitted for liquidation purposes.
- 5. In addition to what FARE can provide to the regional offices, it is suggested that funds be programmed from Regional funds for the following:
 - a. Purchase of reference books for its own regional library
 - b. Provisions for partial scholarships for personnel who are undertaking advanced studies in courses relevant or related to agrarian reform in local institutions. A thesis support of ₱2,000.00 may be authorized out of the Regional allotment.
- Please read pertinent Presidential instructions on personnel training and management on these matters.
