SUBJECT : REGIONAL CONFERENCES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS ON AGRARIAN REFORM

1. For information and appropriate action, the Ministry of Agrarian Reform, in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and Culture, will conduct regional conferences in connection with the nationwide implementation of instructional materials developed for elementary, secondary and higher education levels integrating agrarian reform concepts in the educational system of the country. Details for the regional conferences are outlined in the attachment to this memorandum.
2. Instructional materials developed for the following academic levels shall be implemented during the current school year 1980-81:
  - a. Higher Education - Modules 1 to 10 (English and Filipino Editions)
  - b. Secondary Education - Second, Third and Fourth Year Teachers' Guides
  - c. Elementary Education - Grades Two and Three Readers and Manuals, Grades Four, Five and Six Teachers' Guides and Accompanying Posters
3. The scope of implementation of the instructional materials shall be limited to the same school divisions of each region as in the initial implementation phase conducted during the school year 1978-1979.
4. Members of the MAR-MEC Curriculum Committee who will conduct the regional conferences are organized into Teams. They are representatives from the Ministry of Education and Culture, St. Mary's College and Ministry of Agrarian Reform. Participants and other personnel involved in this regional conferences are listed in the enclosure to this memorandum.

6. The Agrarian Reform Education Service (ARES) will assist each region with two thousand and five hundred (P2,500.00) pesos from FARE for regional expenditures in connection with this activity.
7. Compliance with this Memorandum is earnestly enjoined.
