MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 13-79

SUBJECT: SUPPLEMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS/ADDENDUM  
GOVERNING THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS OF THE  
OFFICERS OF THE MAR CREDIT COOPERATIVES, INC.

In addition to the rules and regulations in the election of officers of the MAR Credit Cooperatives, Inc. embodied under Memorandum Circular No. 12-79, series of 1979, the following supplemental rules and regulations/addendum are hereby promulgated:

Sec. 1. Who are qualified to vote. MAR employees holding plantilla positions who are bonafide members of the MAR Credit Cooperatives, those who have signed and submitted their authority to deduct from the payroll their contributions or those who opted to pay in cash, are qualified to vote.

Sec. 3. Certificate of candidacy. Any member of the MAR Credit Cooperatives who is qualified to vote may file his certificate of candidacy with the MAR Credit Cooperative Comelec on or before July 18, 1979.

Sec. 6. Date of Election. The election of officers to the MAR Credit Cooperatives shall be held on July 27, 1979, starting at 8:30 o'clock A.M. to 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon.

Sec. 8. Watchers. Each candidate is entitled to one watcher. The name of the watchers shall be submitted by a candidate to the MAR Credit Cooperative Comelec not later than July 25, 1979 at 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon.

Sec. 20. Elective positions. The following are the MAR Credit Cooperatives' elective positions:

- a. 7 members of the Board of Directors
- b. 3 members of the Credit Committee
- c. 3 members of the Election Committee
- d. 3 members of the Supervisory Committee

Strict compliance with the provisions hereinabove stated is hereby enjoined.
