MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. *16 of 6-30-78*
Series of 1978

To effect maximum regulation and control of radio communications and in order to effect optimum and orderly utilization of the radio frequency spectrum pursuant to Letter of Instruction No. 31-A of the President of the Philippines dated September 29, 1972, it is hereby directed that the following guidelines shall be strictly followed:

1. No purchases of Radio Transceiver Equipment shall be made unless it is properly coordinated with DAR Communication Unit and the Intelligence Security Unit which shall determine the necessity of procurement, kind, number and capacity of transceiver.

2. Request for authority for the use of any portion of the Radio frequency spectrum from the Radio Control Office and its field offices shall be coursed thru the DAR Communication Unit and Intelligence Security Unit (ISU). The said offices shall determine compliance with the terms and conditions imposed by the Radio Control Office (RCO), to include the following:

- a. Frequency or frequencies to be used
- b. Location of the station
- c. Maximum power output allowable
- d. Type of emission
- e. Bandwidth
- f. Directivity of maximum radiation
- g. Time of operation
- h. Points of communication
- i. Description of Equipment
- j. Call sign to be used

3. Installation and repair of radio transceiver equipment shall be made only by or under the supervision of a duly authorized technician from the Central Office.

4. The operation of Radio Transceiver shall be handled only by duly licensed radio operators.

5. Radio transceiver equipments shall not be transferred from one place to another within the region without prior authority from the Central Office.

Strict compliance is hereby enjoined.
