BAC Resolution No. 12, Series of 2021**

**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING FAILURE OF BIDDING FOR THE  
PROCUREMENT OF SECURITY SERVICES FOR THE DAR CENTRAL OFFICE  
FOR CY 2021 (Under PBD-21-01)**

**WHEREAS**, on March 24, 2021, the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR), under the General Appropriations Act (GAA) for 2021, posted an Invitation to Bid at the PhilGEPS and DAR websites, for the procurement of Security Services for the DAR Central Office for CY 2021 for eight (8) months, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of **Philippine Pesos Seventeen Million Three Hundred Ninety-Seven Thousand Forty-Six and Sixteen Centavos only (PhP17,397,046.16)**. (Refer to Annex "A" for the Invitation to Bid with Reference Number 7568904);

**WHEREAS**, on March 31, 2021, there were three (3) prospective bidders who attended the online pre-bid conference via Microsoft Teams, namely: 1) Top Watch Security and Investigation Services, Inc., 2) Agilex Security Agency, Inc., 3) Militant Security Services, (refer to Annex "B" for the attendance);

**WHEREAS**, on April 7, 2021, Supplemental Bid Bulletin (SBB) No. 1 was posted at the PhilGEPS and DAR websites to officially make clarifications on the issues and queries that were raised by prospective bidders during the pre-bid conference to supersede the previous issuances relative to the subject procurement, (refer to Annex "C" for the SBB and PhilGEPS posting);

**WHEREAS**, on April 14, 2021, on the deadline of submission of bids, two (2) bidders submitted their bids, namely: 1) Top Watch Security and Investigation Services, Inc., 2) KARPA II Security Services, and during the opening of bids on even date, both bidders were declared disqualified for failure to submit some of the required documents that would support their compliance with the technical specifications, (refer to Annex "D" for the Abstract of Bids as Read);

**WHEREAS**, on April 16, 2021, both aforesaid bidders submitted their Motions for Reconsideration (MR), (refer to Annex "E" and "E-1" for the MRs) which were denied by the BAC in their letter on the same date, (refer to Annex "F" and "F-1" for the BAC's denial to MRs);


**WHEREAS**, on April 26, 2021, the BAC, upon confirmation by the BAC Secretariat that both aforesaid bidders did not file any protest with the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE), declared a failure of bidding for the said procurement activity and for the conduct of rebidding the same;


**WHEREFORE**, premises considered, the BAC-Primary, in its meeting on April 26, 2021, resolved to recommend to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE), the following:


1. To declare a failure of bidding for the procurement of Security Services for the DAR Central Office for CY 2021 (for eight months) under PBD-21-01 (Re-bid); and
2. To conduct a second (2<sup>nd</sup>) re-bid upon review of the bidding documents and/or other requirements, if necessary.






