: CERTIFICATION FROM THE COURT OF APPEALS AS A REQUIREMENT FOR THE ISSUANCE OF ENTRY OF JUDGMENT

In reiteration of the August 21, 2000 Board (DARAB) Resolution No. 08-06-(05) clarifying certain policies and procedures in the management of cases by DAR Adjudication Board, particularly in respect of entering the decision or resolution in the Book of Entry of Judgment and, in reference to the specific documentary requirement of Court of Appeals (CA) certification in the DARAB Citizen's Charter in fulfillment of the prescribed timeline under the Anti-Red Tape Act (ARTA) as amended by R.A 11032 (Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018), the requesting party is now required to submit a Certification from the Court of Appeals stating that there is no Petition for Review filed before it relative to a DARAB case before an Entry of Judgment be issued.

Be it emphasized that strictly no request for issuance of Entry of Judgment shall be given due course and processed unless said Court of Appeals Certification among other documentary requirements have been completely submitted and sufficient in form and substance.
