CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this _____ day of February 2022 between the DEPARTMENT OF AGRARIAN REFORM (DAR) of Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City, Philippines, (hereinafter called "the Entity") of the one part and VIGILANT INVESTIGATIVE AND SECURITY AGENCY, INC. of 2113 dela Rosa Street, Barangay Pio del Pilar, Makati City, Philippines (hereinafter called "the Service Provider") of the other part;

WHEREAS, on November 27, 2021 (Early Procurement Activity), the Entity invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, particularly Procurement of Security Services for the DAR Central Office for CY 2022 and has accepted a Bid by the Service Provider for those goods and services in the sum of Philippine Pesos Twenty-Three Million Nine Hundred Seventeen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen and Sixty Centavos only (PhP23,917,713.60) inclusive of taxes.

WHEREAS, as resolved by the Bids and Awards Committee (Primary) through Resolution No. 04 series of 2022 dated January 28, 2022, VIGILANT INVESTIGATIVE AND SECURITY AGENCY, INC., is awarded the contract for Security Services for a period of ten (10) months only, as the procurement process was not completed within the month of December 2021, thus, from March 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022 in the sum of Philippine Pesos Nineteen Million Nine Hundred Thirty-One Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Eight only (PhP19,931,428.00) being the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder (LCRB), (hereinafter called "the Contract Price").

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
- 2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:

Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.
- 3. In consideration for the sum of Philippine Pesos Nineteen Million Nine Hundred Thirty-One Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Eight only (PhP19,931,428.00) or such other sums as may be ascertained, VIGILANT INVESTIGATIVE AND SECURITY AGENCY, INC. agrees to provide Security Services for CY 2022 for a period of ten (10) months from March 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022 in accordance with his/her/its Bid.
- 4. The DEPARTMENT OF AGRARIAN REFORM (DAR) agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the contract at the time and in the manner prescribed by the contract. In case of delays in the performance of the required services specified in this Contract due to the Service Provider's fault, the Procuring Entity shall deduct from the Contract Price, as liquidated damages, the applicable rate of one tenth (1/10) of one percent of the cost of the unperformed portion for every day of delay until actual delivery or performance. The maximum deduction shall be ten percent (10%) of the amount of contract. Once the maximum is reached, the Procuring Entity may rescind or terminate the Contract pursuant to Section 68 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA 9184, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.
