Similar Contract shall refer to Supply and	Will the DAR accept a contract with the title "iCT Equipment" which is composed of several Desktop and Laptop Computers? The same was not titled as "Supply and Delivery of Desktop Computers and Printers".	Yes, it is acceptable and is considered a similar contract. SLCC should be supported by documents, subject to detailed bid evaluation by the TWG if it is indeed a similar contract.
Delivery of Computers and Printers.	Does it require 50% of the project for the "ICT Equipment" or 50% of the composition for Desktop and Laptop Computers?	The SLCC should at least be equal to 50% of the estimated cost and should be composed of desktops and/or laptops.
