CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this ___ day of December 2022 between the **Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR)** of Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City, Philippines, (hereinafter called “the Procuring Entity”), of the one part and **KServico Trade, Inc.**, of 111 12th Streer, Cubao Quezon City, (hereinafter called “the Supplier”) of the other part:

WHEREAS, the Procuring Entity invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, viz., Procurement of 225 units Motorcycles, Lot 1 – for Luzon DAR Regional Offices (DARROs) and has accepted a Bid by the Supplier for the supply of those goods and services in the sum of **Philippine Pesos Twenty-Eight Million One Hundred Two Thousand Five Hundred (PhP28,102,500.00)** (hereinafter called “the Contract Price”).

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - A. KServico Trade, Inc. Bid, Eligibility Requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals;
 - B. the Schedule of Requirements;
 - C. the Technical Specifications;
 - D. the General Conditions of the Contract;
 - E. the Special Conditions of the Contract;
 - F. the Performance Security;
 - G. the Procuring Entity’s Notice of Award;
3. In consideration for the sum of Philippine Pesos Twenty-Eight Million One Hundred Two Thousand Five Hundred (PhP28,102,500.00) or such other sums as may be ascertained, KServico Trade, Inc. agrees to supply and deliver Lot 1 – 225 units of Motorcycles for Luzon DAR Regional Offices (DARROs) in accordance with its Bid.
4. The Procuring Entity hereby covenants to pay the Supplier in consideration for the supply and delivery of 225 units Motorcycles, Lot 1 – for Luzon DAR Regional Offices (DARROs) and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable

under the provisions of the contract at the time and in the manner prescribed by the contract. In case of delays in the delivery/performance of the required services specified in this Contract due to the Supplier's fault, the Procuring Entity shall deduct from the Contract Price, as liquidated damages, the applicable rate of one tenth (1/10) of one percent of the cost of the unperformed portion for every day of delay until actual delivery or performance. The maximum deduction shall be ten percent (10%) of the amount of contract. Once the maximum is reached, the Procuring Entity may rescind or terminate the Contract pursuant to GCC Clause 23, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.


