The Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR) has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Support to Parcelization of Individual Titling and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services ("the Services") includes providing technical guidance and support to the CPMO in designing and delivering appropriate and responsive capability building and technical assistance interventions with properly developed guidelines, TLD program design, content, modules/session plans, presentation/learning materials, guidepost, and activities, among others for twelve (12) months renewable yearly starting **December 29, 2023**.

1. Must be a holder of Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture, Human Resource Development, Psychology, Education, Economics, Rural Development, Gender and Women Studies, and other related discipline;
2. A Graduate Degree is an advantage;
3. With at least five (5) years relevant professional work experience in a similar function/capacity;
4. Developed at least two (2) comprehensive training modules/learning packages/training manual;
5. Experienced organizing and facilitating at least five (5) partners'/stakeholders' forum/conferences/workshops and engaging TLD service providers for information sharing and/or leverage/mobilize expertise, tools and resources support;
6. Involved in at least two (2) foreign assisted rural development projects related to Capability Building and Technical Assistance;
7. Work experience in land tenure implementation is an advantage; and
8. Attended at least 40 hours of training related to Competency-based Capability/Capacity Building
