REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES DEPARTMENT OF AGRARIAN REFORM Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City

DAR and CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D. shall be collectively called PARTIES.

WHEREAS, DAR invited bids for the Supply and Delivery of Certificate of Condonations and received bids from two (2) prospective bidders; DAR opened, and evaluated the bids, and declared the bid of CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D. as Single Calculated Bid; after post-qualification, DAR declared the bid of CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D. as Single Calculated Responsive Bid in the sum of PHILIPPINE PESOS EIGHTY-FIVE MILLION SIX HUNDRED FORTY-NINE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED PESOS (PHP 85,649,400.00) ONLY, inclusive of taxes, hereinafter called the "Contract Price".

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. In this Contract, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Terms and Conditions of Contract referred to.
- 2. The following documents, including the relevant provisions of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Contract, viz:
 - a. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - iv. Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 1 dated 11 June 2024, Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 2 dated 18 June 2024, and Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 3 dated 24 June 2024:
 - b. CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D.'s bid, including the eligibility requirements, technical and financial proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;
 - Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D.'s bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted, including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the DAR's bid evaluation;
 - c. Performance Security;
 - Notice of Award (NOA) of Contract; and the CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D.'s conforme thereto; and
 - e. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or DAR in the PBDs. CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D. agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed (NTP) and Warranty Security, if applicable, shall likewise form part of the Contract.
- The items shall be delivered by CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D. at DAR Central Office, Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City within 30 CALENDAR DAYS from receipt of the NTP, and in accordance with Section VI. Schedule of Requirements of the Bidding Documents.

Partial delivery shall be allowed upon agreement of the PARTIES. In such case, DAR shall notify CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D. orally or in writing to make partial delivery in accordance with the requirements of DAR.

Risk and title to the items shall not be deemed to have passed from CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D. to DAR until the receipt and final acceptance of the items by DAR at the aforesaid delivery site.

4. The items must comply with the standards and/or requirements provided in Section VII. Technical Specifications of the Bidding Documents, which is hereto attached as Annex "A" and made an integral part hereof.

CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D. shall not deliver items which are not in compliance with the said standards and requirements. CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D. may, however, in lieu of the approved technical specifications, deliver items of equivalent, higher or superior technical specifications subject to the evaluation and recommendation of the end-user or implementing unit. In any such case, said substitution shall not result in any additional cost or undue burden to DAR.

- 5. DAR shall pay the Contract Price to CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D. upon receipt and acceptance of the items by DAR, and submission of documentary requirements by CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D.. The said payment shall be subject to applicable and existing disbursement, accounting, and auditing rules and procedures.
- 6. CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D. shall be liable for liquidated damages in an amount equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the delayed items scheduled for delivery, for every day of delay until such goods are finally delivered and accepted by DAR. DAR shall deduct the liquidated damages from any money due or which may be due to CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D., or collect from any of the securities of warranties posted by CETIS PH JV CETIS D.D.. Once the accumulated amount of liquidated damages reaches 10% of the Contract Price, DAR may rescind or terminate the Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies available under the circumstances.
- 7. **IN WITNESS** whereof the **PARTIES** hereto have caused this Contract to be executed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines on the day and year first above written.
